Policy Statement

At Bow Lane Pre-school we are very fortunate to have supportive and friendly parents. Our parents recognise the importance of a good working relationship to equip children with the necessary skills for later life. For these reasons we welcome and encourage parent/carers to participate fully within the pre-school.

The purpose of this policy is to provide a reminder to all parents and visitors to our pre-school about expected conduct so that we can work together to ensure a safe and positive pre-school environment for our children.

Respect and concern for others and their rights

We expect parents and carers to show respect and concern for others by:-

- Supporting the respectful ethos of our pre-school by setting a good example in their own speech and behaviour towards all members of our pre-school.
- Working together with pre-school staff for the benefit of children. This includes approaching staff to resolve any issues of concern and to discuss and clarify specific events in an appropriate way.
- Reinforcing the pre-school policy on behaviour.

In order to support a peaceful and safe pre-school environment, the pre-school does not tolerate;-

- Disruptive behaviour which interferes with the operation of the pre-school.
- Using loud and/or offensive language or displaying temper.
- Threatening harm or the use of physical aggression towards another adult or child. This includes approaching someone else's child in order to discuss or chastise them and physical punishment against your own child on pre-school premises.
- Damaging or destroying pre-school property

- Abusive, threatening, malicious or inflammatory emails, phone or social network messages.
- Smoking and consumption of alcohol or other drugs or accessing the pre-school site whilst intoxicated.

The above behaviours on school premises will be reported to the appropriate authorities and the management may prohibit an offending adult from entering the pre-school grounds to safeguard our pre-school community.

We trust that parents, carers and visitors will fully support this Code of conduct.
