The Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements: Staff: child ratios

Providers must ensure that adults looking after children, or having unsupervised access to them, are suitable to do so.

ADULT:CHILD RATIO POLICY

At Bow lane Pre-school we abide by the specific legal requirements with regard to adult:child ratios as set out in the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage (2012) in the following way:

For children aged 2 in our setting:

- There must be at least one member of staff for every 4 children.
- At least one member of staff must hold a full and relevant Level 3.
- At least half of all other staff must hold a full and relevant Level 2.

For children aged 3 in our setting:

- There must be at least one member of staff for every 8 children.
- At least one member of staff must hold a full and relevant Level 3.
- At least half of all other staff must hold a full and relevant Level 2.

When we take the children out on trips we will maintain the following adult:child ratio:

- For children aged 2 in our setting 1:2 ratio.
- For children aged 3 in our setting 1:3 ratio.

This is different from our ratio with regards to daily drop offs to St John Fisher and Hatfeild primary schools.
